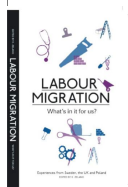

Liberal publications: "Labour migration - What's in it for us?"

The EU needs skilled migrants! Today the Parliament's Employment committee unanimously adopted the report on the integration of migrants, its effects on the labour markets and the external dimension of social security coordination. Education, training and employment remain the key to a successful integration. At the same time anti-EU and anti-immigrations sentiments seem to be growing. This new extensive study on the subject of labour migration has recently been published by the European Liberal Forum, FORES and the Centreforum.
