In its aftermath, new democracies and market economies emerged, but also new political, social, economic and institutional problems arose. Now it is high time to assess the impact of the historic events of 1989. Leading Greek and German scholars will discuss the impact of the fall of the Wall, and of the socialist regimes for Europe, the Balkans, and Greece.
